What can I donate?

We accept most cars, trucks, vans, fleet vehicles, trailers, boats, motorcycles and RV's (wrecked or not). If you have any questions about what you can donate, please call us at 1.866.425.3869.



Is my car donation tax deductible?

Yes, vehicles donated to charity and that benefit a non-profit classified with the IRS as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization are tax deductible. All individual tax situations are different, so please check with your tax professional to determine how you may benefit.

What do I need to do to donate my vehicle?

You'll need to have the title and keys. Submit our Car Donation Form or call us toll-free at 1.866.425.3869.



Am I guaranteed that my vehicle donation will be accepted?

We accept most cars, trucks, vans, fleet vehicles, trailers, boats and RV's. However, exceptions may apply, depending on factors such as the distance to our

nearest towing facility, and various other market dynamics which also affect the overall process. Should this be the case, we will do our best to inform you as promptly as possible so that you can make other arrangements.

How is the value of my car donation determined?

Thanks to new tax law (in effect as of January 2005), the IRS has taken the guesswork out of determining the value of your vehicle. You may deduct the full price that we receive from the sale of your vehicle. This greatly simplifies the process for you, the donor, because you no longer have to research and come up with an estimate of the fair market value of the vehicle. This also eliminates the risk of you getting into trouble by overstating the value of your deduction on your tax return. You'll know exactly the amount you may deduct, eliminating guesswork, and saving you both time and risk.



You will receive a receipt at the time we pick up your vehicle, and as a follow up we will send you a second receipt later, as soon as we sell it, letting you know the exact amount for which it sold. That amount is your tax deduction.

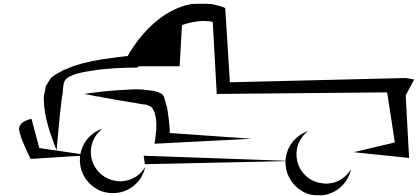


Will you pick up vehicles in any city of Yamhill county?

How long will it take to pick up my car?

We can normally pick up your car within a few days. If you need your car picked up sooner, where feasible we will work with you on this. We will contact you to set up a time to pick up your vehicle, you do not need to be present.
